Toward the beginning of the month, we were able to enjoy a partial view of the eclipse that crossed through North America. We all enjoyed being able to see this unique miracle. Charity and Renata also got to see Querétaro for the first time as we took a quick day trip there in the middle of the month. We are also glad to report that our issues with INM were resolved quickly and without excessive headache. We are very grateful for all of the exciting things we got to see during April!

In México, they celebrate "Día del Niño" (Children's Day) every year on April 30th. Our church decided to celebrate a little early on the Saturday before, the 27th. We had quite a few of drive in kids and bus kids come to enjoy some time with inflatables, foosball, and some delicious treats. We were glad to help some with this, and we are also glad Charity and Renata got to enjoy some of the fun as well. Also in ministry during April, I was able to lead a man named Eduardo to Christ. Please pray that he would grow in Christ and that his family would also be receptive to the Gospel.

We had a bit of a surprise to wrap up the month. As Brittany was about to preheat the oven for breakfast on Sunday the 28th, the oven exploded on her, and that explosion caused significant damage to our kitchen cabinets and windows. Apparently, the dial that controlled the gas was faulty and was allowing gas to build up in the oven while in the "off" position. We praise the Lord that Brittany did not sustain major injuries, and we are also grateful that no one else was hurt.
